Cookie Category	Purpose	Examples
Strictly Necessary	Fundamental to site operation. They enable you to move around the site and access secure areas like your client portal.	Client session tokens, security tokens (CSRF protection).
Functionality	Allow the site to remember choices you make (such as username or region) to provide enhanced features.	"Remember Me" login selections or currency preferences.
Analytical/Performance	Help us count visitors and see how they move around the site so we can improve the user experience.	Google Analytics.
Third-Party	Set by trusted partners to provide specific services through our site.	Stripe & PayPal (fraud prevention and secure payment processing); Support ticket widgets.

4. Managing Cookies

You have the right to decide whether to accept or reject non-essential cookies.

- **Cookie Consent Banner:** Upon your first visit, a banner will ask for your consent to set non-essential cookies. You may choose to decline these.
- **Browser Controls:** You can adjust your browser settings to refuse cookies. However, please be aware that disabling cookies will negatively affect the functionality of the Lamico client area, including login capabilities. We generally recommend that you do not disable cookies for the best experience.
